
#### DEFINITION



All measurements are in Yards All measurements on fairways are forward measurements to the middle of the green.

A deceiving tee shot to a generous landing area with the ideal play line directly towards the distant fairway bunker. A strategic 2nd shot requires you to avoid a well placed fairway bunker before your approach to a well protected green.






This long Par 3 is stunningly surrounded by a native casuarina forest. Be careful as club selection is critical due to the prevailing winds





This long Par 4 has well placed bunkers through the fairway waiting to capture any errant tee shot. The second shot requires precision to an amphi theatre green setting.





The shortest Par 4 on the Montgomerie Link: requires a well placed tee shot from an elevated tee to a hidden landing area. Be careful of the water on the right!





A short, full water carry Par 3 to a very receptive green requires careful club selectio due to the native vegetated dune above the green sheltering the hole from prevailing winds. A knockdown shot may be the play.






This hole features an historic gun placement pillbox towards the right hand side of the tee box. A downhill tee shot requires a right side placement on the fairway for a risk and reward 2nd shot to a green well protected on the left hand side by the water.





A challenging Par 4 with a difficult uphill tee shot to a well protected fairway. Play close attention to your 2nd shot play line, although it is blind it is free of hazards.






PAR 4

Mens Index: 4

This naturally undulating fairway will feed the ball left to right unless well placed towards the left hand fairway bunker. This will provide a clear 2nd shot to green.

Teeing off through the shoot of casuarinas this stunning hole requires two very well struck shots before reaching this large 900 square meter green protected by water or the right.





This forgiving open fairway allows you to negotiate this true dogleg over several strategically placed native casuarina pines This deep green requires you to pay close attention to the pin position.





Do not land short of this uphill Par 3 green. Ensure you take one extra club to avoid the streacherous bunkers positioned short of the green.






This extremely well bunkered Par 5 requires 3 strategically placed shots to negotiate the 12 bunkers on the hole. Once reaching the greei play close attention to leaving yourself an uphill putt.






This straightaway downhill tee shot gives you the chance to open this lengthy Par 4, but be careful not to miss your 2nd shot to the right as danger awaits. Upon arrival at the green, busure to leave your ball pin high or a long putt may be required.





Montgomerie says: "Give it all you've got".





A reachable water carry Par 4 allows the aggresive hitter to reach the green in 1. Though any missed shot will likely end in a difficult place.





When playing this stunning hole with its downhill sloping left to right fairway, avoid the right hand side fairway bunker to enab an open shot to the large green well protected by bunkers and water.





Play along the vegetated dune, carefully manoeuver your tee shot through the well placed fairway bunker to set yourself up for a strategic approach to a well guarded green





The longest par 5 at Montgomerie Links and a great chance to finish with a birdle before retiring to the clubhouse. This slightly uphill hole, tempts the long hitters to go for the green in two. This is provided you can avoid a series of fairway bunkers before approaching an undulated, elevated green.
